# Comments from the Chief Electoral Officer on the April 24, 2023, Provincial By-elections

On March 23, 2023, the Lieutenant-Governor in Council issued an order in council directing that writs of election be issued for by-elections to be held in the electoral districts of Bathurst East-Nepisiguit-Saint-Isidore, Dieppe and Restigouche Chaleur on Monday April 24, 2023.

The three seats had been vacant since the fall of 2022, following the resignation of the three members of the legislature who held those seats.

In anticipation of the by-elections being called sometime in the New Year, on December 1, 2022, I appointed a returning officer for each of the electoral districts. In mid-January when the three returning officers came to Fredericton for training, I directed the three returning officers to return to their respective ridings and identify and secure space they could use as the location of their returning offices.

As directed, I issued writs of election for the three by-elections on March 23, 2023, kicking off a 30-day election campaign for the three electoral districts.

At the close of nominations, the Liberal Party of New Brunswick, the Parti Vert N.B. Green Party and the New Brunswick New Democratic Party each had candidates nominated in the three electoral districts. The Progressive Conservative Party of New Brunswick chose not to field a candidate in the electoral district of Bathurst East-Nepisiguit-Saint-Isidore, but ran candidates in the other two electoral districts. The People's Alliance of New Brunswick did not have candidates in any of the three ridings.

A combined total of 32,974 electors were eligible to vote in the three electoral districts. At the close of polls on Monday April 24, 2023, a total of 12,359 ballots had been cast, representing a voter participation rate of 37.48%.

The direct cost of administrating these three by-elections was approximately \$450,000. In addition, the maximum costs for the reimbursements of the 11 candidates' election expenses would be an extra \$108,472.

Thank you to the many election workers who worked for us in the three electoral districts during the by-elections, as well as our head office staff for making sure these by-elections ran smoothly.

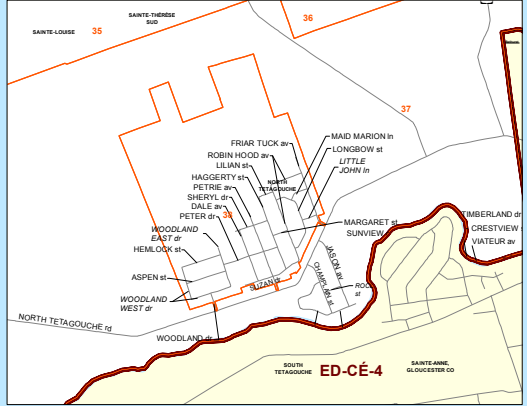

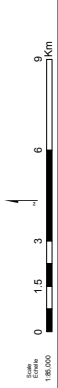
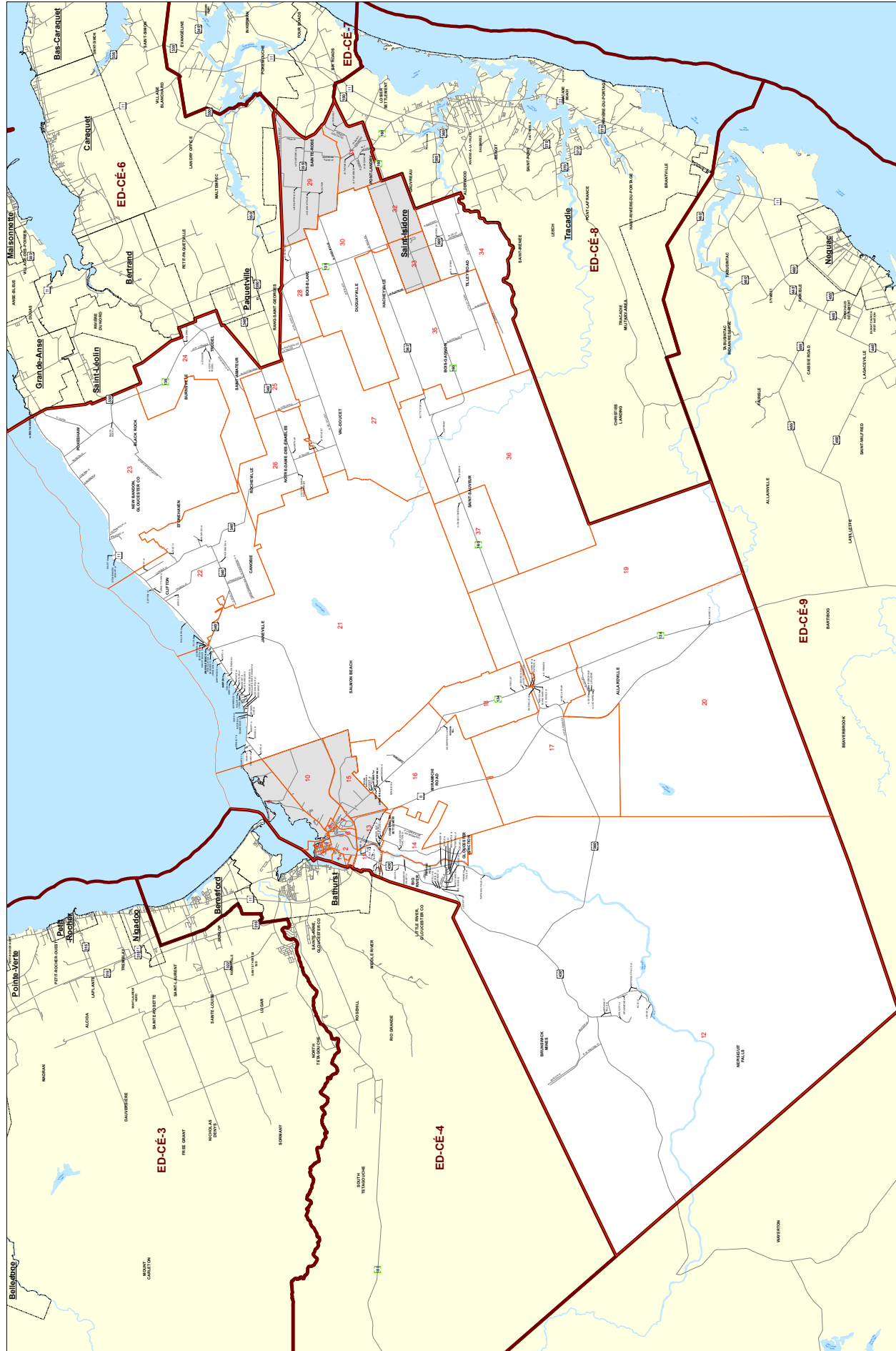

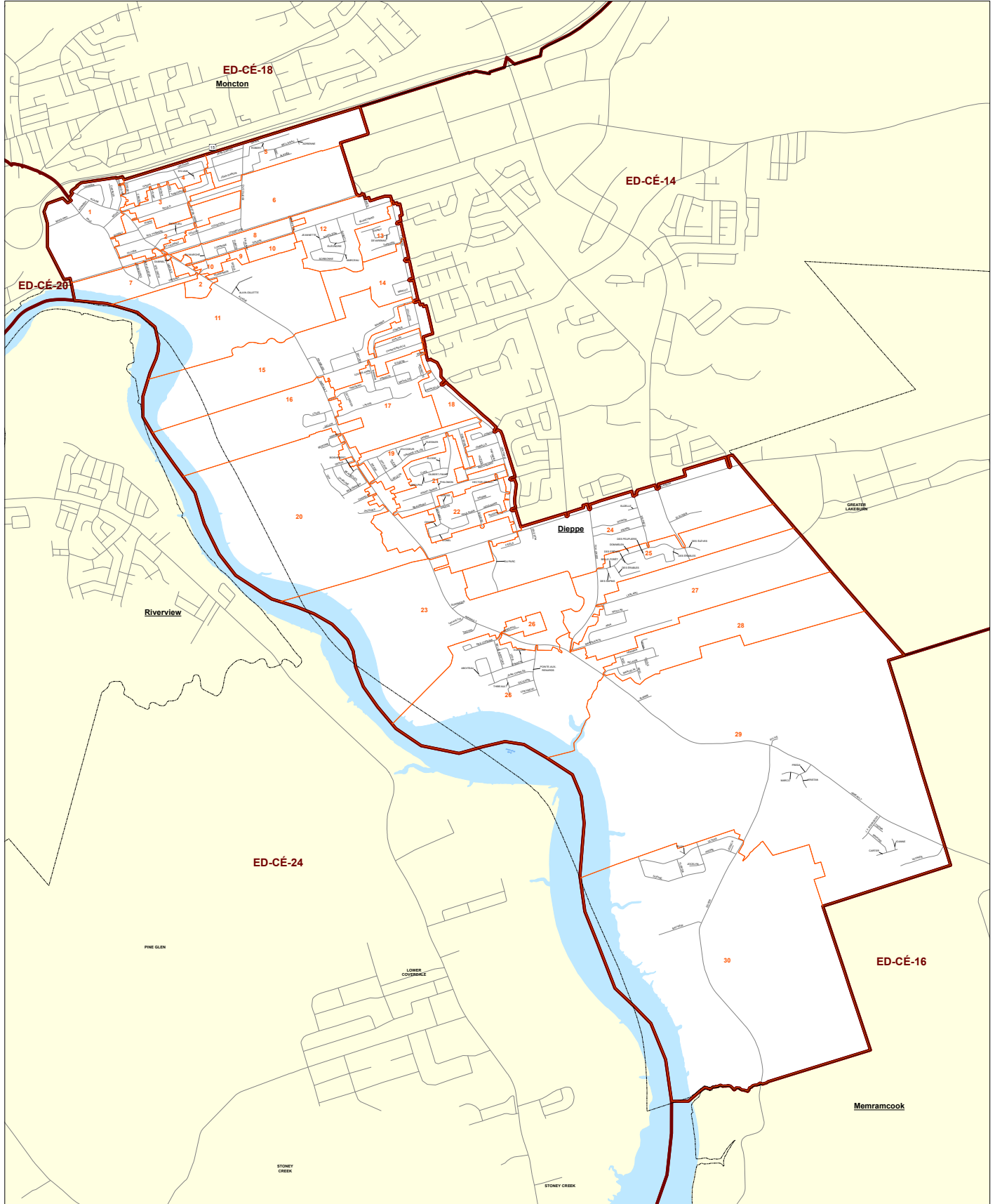
