

# **Elector Qualifications**

#### You are qualified to vote if you:

- are a Canadian citizen;
- are at least eighteen years of age on polling day;
- have been ordinarily resident in the <u>Province</u> for 40 days immediately preceding the date of the election;
- will be living in the electoral district on Election Day.




#### Students


- A person in attendance at a recognized educational institution and for those purposes resides in a polling division other then that in which they ordinarily reside may have their name:
  - Placed on the list of the polling division in which they ordinarily reside; or
  - Placed on the list of the polling division in which they reside while attending the recognized educational institution.



#### **Voter Information Cards**

- Mailed 14 days before election.
- Up to 5 Voter Information Cards in the same envelope.
- If more than 6 electors at same household, individual envelopes are sent.







#### **Lists of Electors**

- "Preliminary List" created from Register of Electors at start of election.
- Updated throughout election.
- "Revised List" created prior to advance polls.
- "Official List" created prior to Election Day.
- "Final List" created after election.




#### **Candidate Lists of Electors**

- Agent must complete P 04 101, Declaration Regarding Candidate's, MLA's and Registered Parties' use of the Lists of Electors prior to receiving the information.
  - Later in the election period, additional updates may be provided to the candidates without signing another Form P 04 101.
- Provided P 04 103, Declaration Regarding the Authorized Use of the Lists of Electors.
  - For use within the political party.



#### **Candidate Portal**

- Once a nomination is accepted, Returning Officer creates Candidate
  Portal account for the agent or candidate
- The system will automatically send an email
- The candidate must register their info and verify their email address






#### **Candidate Access to Lists of Electors**

- A candidate can access:
  - List of Electors in that candidate's contest area (Preliminary, Revised, or Official)
  - Only the electors who have voted to that point in the election in that candidate's contest area
- "Electors Having Voted" will be updated every day when voting is occurring.
- "Electors Having Voted" will be updated every 2 hours during advance or ordinary polling days.
