Oral Oath or Affirmation of Scrutineer

(Municipal Elections Act, SNB, 1979, c. M-21-01, s. 23 and ss. 30(1))

Notes to Poll Supervisor:

- This oral oath is to be administered by the Poll Supervisor upon initial admission to the Polling Station of a scrutineer who will be observing voting procedures and/or counting of the ballots.
- A candidate shall not have more than one scrutineer present at a polling station at any time during voting hours or during the counting of the votes.
