	84.3(3) An application for registration shall be sent to the Supervisor and shall include the following information and documents:  (a) if the third party is an individual, the name, address, telephone number and signature of the individual;  (b) if the third party is a corporation, the following information:  (i) the name, address and telephone number of the corporation; and  (ii) the name, address, telephone number and signature of an officer who has signing authority for the corporation;  (c) if the third party is a group, the following information:  (i) the name, address and telephone number of the group; and  (ii) the name, address and telephone number and signature of the individual who is responsible for the group;  (d) the address and telephone number of the location where the third party's books and records are kept and to which communications may be addressed;  (e) the name, address and telephone number of the third party's chief financial officer;  (f) the name and address of each financial institution at which election advertising contributions to the third party will be deposited;  N/A (g) the source of election advertising contributions received by the third party during the 6 months preceding the application for registration;  (h) a declaration signed by the third party's chief financial officer accepting his or her appointment; and  (ii) a declaration that the third party is acting independently of and not in collusion with a registered political party, a registered district association, a candidate or another third party.
	84.3(4) An application under subsection (3) shall be on a form provided by the Supervisor.
	84.3(5) A declaration under paragraph (3)(i) shall be signed by the individual or officer referred to in paragraph (3)(a) or subparagraph (3)(b)(ii) or (c)(ii), as the case may be.
